## DSA Summit 2024: Experts descend on Geneva to showcase spectrum sharing successes

**May 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2024:** With exciting developments within the 6 GHz band continuing to be announced across the globe, the [Dynamic Spectrum Alliance](#) (DSA)'s 2024 Global Summit will empower spectrum experts to promote their latest technologies and case studies designed to bridge the digital divide and ensure affordable and sustainable connectivity for all.

Taking place on September 23 - 24 2024, the 2024 DSA Summit will consider the requirements for a digitalized, global gigabit society, and how recent landmark decisions – such as the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) and its authorization of [Automatic Frequency Coordination \(AFC\)](#) systems within the 6 GHz band – are maximising the available spectrum for new, innovative broadband services.

“2024 is already proving to be a pivotal year where Wi-Fi is concerned,” said DSA President Martha Suarez. “In the past few months we have already seen some major regulatory changes take place worldwide, and this has already led to significant technological advancements in spectrum sharing, and the adoption of Wi-Fi connectivity. This year’s Summit will give attendees the chance to hear from the regulators driving innovation within their own countries, and how these successes can be used as the tinder for the development of a true digitalised society.”

The 2024 DSA Summit will be co-located with [Wi-Fi World Congress Europe](#), which takes place 23-25 September 2024 at the Hilton Hotel Conference Centre. Both events will focus on the hottest topics and trends within Wi-Fi, including the latest standards, spectrum allocations, technologies and solutions for both residential and business applications.

Across the two-days, invited speakers will cover a range of topics, such as dynamic spectrum access, Wi-Fi 6E and 7 technologies, Automated Frequency Coordination (AFC) systems, the importance of Wireless Internet Service Providers (WISPs) for affordable broadband access, and much more.

“We are delighted to be partnering with [Wi-Fi NOW](#) once again for this year’s Summit,” continued Suarez. “Both organizations are devoted to the promotion of Wi-Fi, as it remains the best option for delivering high-quality, high-performance connectivity for everyone, even

in unserved and underserved regions. The DSA Summit and the Wi-Fi World Congress are the premier events to network with key regulators, policymakers, academia, civil organizations, and industry experts.”
